1. Motion to approve minutes of August 21, 2008 by Ed Eramain, seconded by Virge Lorents. Voice vote was all in favor.
2. Sue Westa reviewed the draft results of the survey. Discussion followed.
3. Sue reported that the public workshop is scheduled for October 27th at the Westfield Congregational Church in Danielson. Peter Flinker and Steve Mullen are scheduled to be the facilitators.
4. Flyers are being distributed throughout Town.
5. Sue reported that the UCONN senior studio students are interested in this project of design alternatives for RT 101. It may be their focus during the final 6 weeks of this semester. Some students may attend the Public Workshop on Oct. 27th. The students will begin to refine their design ideas which will culminate in some drawings.
6. Sue reminded the team of the next session of the Discovery Process on Oct. 18th from 8:30 AM to 5 PM at the Killingly Public Library. Several positive comments were given regarding this training.
7. Other: Peter Flinker of the Dodson Group presented for review a large map of the RT 101 corridor. The map's scale is 1 inch = 200'. There was an overlay with full build out representing residential and commercial development which may be used for the Workshop.
